Pool Rules and Regulations

ALL RESIDENTS AND GUESTS USING THE POOL INCUR A CERTAIN RISK. NEITHER THE ASSOCIATION CORPORATION, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS NOR HERRIMAN & ASSOCIATES, INC. AND ITS REPRESENTATIVES SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT, LOSS OR INJURY IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH USE.

All Association Members, their guests, their tenants and their tenants' guests must obey the following rules and guidelines to ensure the safety and consideration of all participants. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations may result in fines or loss of privileges or both.

1. The use of the pool is at your own risk. There is **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.**
2. **NO DIVING.**
3. The pool hours are from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm.
4. WALK - no running or rough play within the pool area or bathrooms.
5. Immediately prior to entering the pool, a cleansing shower using warm water and soap is required. Suntan lotions must be showered off before entering the water.
6. Persons using the pool must be attired in clean, bona fide swim wear. "Cut-off" jeans or pants, tee shirts, or street socks are not acceptable.
7. Children 12 and under are not permitted without an adult over the age of 18.
REMEMBER – THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.
8. Floating devices or other objects which may pose a hazard or hinder efficient use of the pool will not be permitted.
9. Running, boisterous or rough play, ball throwing, diving or other accident prone and disruptive activities are not permitted.
10. Glass containers or food of any kind are not permitted in the enclosure area.
11. In consideration of other residents in proximity of the pool, amplified sound equipment is not to be used in the pool area.
12. Persons under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants will be denied access to the pool area.
13. Smoking is not permitted in the pool or pool area.
14. Persons wearing bandages or suffering from infectious or communicable diseases shall not use the pool.
15. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose or otherwise polluting the pool water or deck area is forbidden.
16. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a clean diaper and tight fitting plastic pants or a swim diaper. Any pool accidents by anyone will require the closure of the pool area per the Local Health Department.
17. Organized children's parties are not permitted in the pool area.
